1985 (12 rounds) 7 players

TB Herschel Walker who had spent the previous two years with the New Jersey Generals of the USFL. In addition to Walker (fifth round, Dallas), Georgia players drafted included PK Kevin Butler (fourth round, Chicago), TE Scott Williams (ninth round, St. Louis), CB Kevin Harris (11th round, Detroit), OT Mike Weaver (12th round, Detroit), DB Jeff Sanchez (12th round, Pittsburgh), and DT Donald Chumley (12th round, San Francisco, "Mr. Irrelevant").

1989 (12 rounds) 6 players

The six Bulldogs taken in 1989 included TB Tim Worley (first round, Pittsburgh), TB Keith Henderson (third round, San Francisco), DE Richard Tardits (fifth round, St. Louis), TE Troy Sadowski (sixth round, Atlanta), QB Wayne Johnson (11th round, Indianapolis), and OLB Aaron Chubb (12th round, New England).
