## Head Coach Kirby Smart

### *On the eighth straight win over Georgia Tech...*

“This rivalry goes way back, way beyond my ability to comprehend it in terms of years back and way beyond our players’ ability to comprehend it. What I do know is that my senior year, the streak was seven and it ended. That one always sticks with me. So it has been a battle back and forth. Both programs have had their runs, and it’s good for the state.”

### *On the defensive performance...*

“We tackled well. We kept them off-balanced and held them to field goals. We got put in some really bad situations in the second half and responded every time. I’m really proud of the effort and toughness they played with.”

### *On CJ Allen’s return after injury...*

“He’s pretty amazing. He has made a lot of sacrifices. He chose to get the surgery done immediately because he knew that would give him a chance at coming back for this game, and he really wanted to play in this game. He’s a kid from just south of Atlanta. I didn’t think he would be able to, but he’s wired differently. When he was in high school, he would come over here and work out every day he could during camps and just wanted to get better. When I saw him out there on Monday doing a little bit, then Tuesday doing a little bit, and Wednesday doing more and then Thursday he was ready to go. It’s a credit to him and who he is and how much he loves this program because not a lot of kids would have done that coming off of that surgery.”

***On holding Georgia Tech to 76 non-sack rushing yards and stopping the run...***

“We’ve talked about it all season. It’s what this program is built on. You’ve got to be able to run it, and you’ve got to be able to stop the run. There was a fourth and one that we barely got, and it’s ok because that’s who we are. We’ve got to be able to run the ball and stop the run. We were able to run the ball efficiently in the first half, and it wasn’t as clean in the second half.”

***On the impact of Drew Bobo’s injury on the offense...***

“Drew’s a great player. He’s one of my best friends. Seeing him go down was tough, but I think Malachi [Toliver] did a great job of stepping up. We didn’t execute as well as we wanted to. I didn’t play as well as I wanted to today, but as long as we get the win, it’s always a good day.”

***On the message to the offense at the end of the game...***

“I knew that if we got the first down, we could shut it down, but I’m glad our defense had our back.”

***On his running game being up to Georgia’s traditional standard...***

“I still have a ways to go. That was the best I have played, but I’m just trying to be the best I can be. I’m trying to continue to work as hard as I possibly can to get on that level.”

***On his performance in the first half...***

“When I get the ball in my hands, I just try to run as hard as I possibly can for the guys on the sideline and the ones on the field with me. I’m trying not to let them down and do all that I possibly can.”

“It means a lot to the defense. Everyone is buying into stopping the run day in and day out at practice, and we get our results by what we do during the week.”

“It felt great to get the win today. Being from Georgia and knowing my mom lives seven minutes from the stadium, it felt great to have my support system here to watch me play today.”
