Head Coach Kirby Smart

On the white uniforms and fans dressing to theme...

"I appreciate the fans buying into it, dressing in white and turning out with some strange weather conditions rolling in. I thought our fan base looked great. It looked awesome."

On what stands out about players getting in the zone...

"They work really hard during the week in practice. I thought Nate (Frazier) ran really hard. I think Gunner (Stockton) did a nice job with the passing game that he was afforded. Balls were a little slick and wet, and I think both teams struggled with that."

On going into next week's SEC matchup...

"We just need to prepare this week the right way and make sure we're communicating and executing during practice to really attack this week"

On his career high of five touchdowns in today's game...

"It feels good. You always want to execute at the end of the day and just do your job."

On the debut of Georgia's white jerseys...

"They're pretty sweet, and I think they looked pretty good. They definitely look a little weird."

On Chauncey Bowens hurdle into the endzone...

"That was nice; that was like a video game hurdle. So, that was pretty awesome."

On continuity, communication and execution between the players...

"It's big. If you look at any offense, you have to be able to communicate at a high level, and I think we do that every single day in practice. You have to be intentional with it, so I feel like we need to just keep doing what we're doing."

On Craig Dandridge's performance as a freshman...

"Craig's been incredible. I mean, real mature for a freshman. He's just shown flashes all through camp, summer, spring, every time. He's out there, he knows what he has. He's studied the playbook great, asked questions, he's acting like a pro. We talk about it a lot."

On Landon Roldan's first career touchdown and getting to play with former high school teammates...

"That was awesome. I love Landon, been here for two years with him now. Just seeing his development has been great, and it's just an exciting moment to celebrate with him. They're [Landon Roldan and Khamari Brooks] are real close. They've known each other for a long time, and they celebrate just as much as if he was a receiver with us, Kamari [Brooks]."

On his team's outing the past two games...

"I think we've gotten out there. We've shown our physicality, our explosiveness, all our abilities. These games are great because we've seen all the things we still need to work on and improve because we got a long season ahead, some good games coming up. I think it's just good self-reflection on us."

"Knowing that we have several guys on the defense that are willing to come out and play running football, so just knowing that it's the next guy up."

Opening Statement...

"Hats off to the Georgia Bulldogs. They are an excellent football team, one of the best in the country. Looking for positives coming out of this game, one thing our young men did was they kept competing. They kept straining. Obviously, it was not good a lot of times. A lot of things we have to get better at if we're going to be a good football team, but one part of football is you've got to keep straining, you've got to keep grinding, you've got to keep competing. I felt like they did that. Now, we've got to go back to the drawing board, fix your problems, find answers and find the right people. Hopefully, we'll be battle-tested as we go through this schedule, but, we want to take this one, put it behind us and try to get better from it."

On the matchup against other coaches he has relationships with...

"It's a great honor to be able to play here and in this stadium. To be able to compete with the best of the best is a great honor, and I have tremendous respect not only for Coach (Kirby) Smart but most of the staff. We know each other very well, and it was great to be able to go out there and compete with them."

"It's only four and a half hours from Bowling Green, it's a good draw. Bowling Green is a beautiful place, great campus, great atmosphere. When the young men come from the state of Georgia, they fall in love with it."
